- Write **titles of books** you read on the lines, whether they are print books, eBooks or audiobooks. Write a title only once, even if you read it for many days. Use another sheet of paper if you need more room.

earn you prizes there this summer. If you return any reading log to the school library in the fall you can earn a

prize there too!
